

“A NIGHT AT THE MOVIES” SHORE DANCE SHOW NOTICE:

DRESS REHEARSALS:

Last Class Before Show:

Please read the important notice regarding changes to the last week of classes

The last class before the show (from Saturday 6th of December to Friday 12th of December) will be a full dress rehearsal. So students need to come fully dressed in their costumes (they will either be given their costumes the week prior, or else during the last class). Please ensure they come to this class with their hair done correctly (see below), and they may wear stage make-up if you wish to have a practice! Ballet student must be wearing ballet stockings and pink ballet shoes (available from www.thedanceshop.co.nz), jazz students must be wearing jazz shoes, and tap students must be wearing tap shoes.

Day of the Show:

Each dance has a short dress rehearsal at Westlake Boys High Auditorium on the stage on the day of the show. Students must wear their complete costume, with hair and make-up, and be dressed and ready to go on the stage 10 minutes before their dress rehearsal time. The dress rehearsal schedule was included in the newsletter, and can be found at the end of this notice.

Students then must arrive back at the auditorium with their costume, hair and make-up done half an hour before the show begins, by 5:30pm. All students need to meet in the upstairs seating area of the auditorium before the show, and family members can go downstairs and take their seats (please note that family members will not be able to sit upstairs, this is allocated for students only).

COSTUMES:

Your child will receive their complete costume at their last class before the show, and you will be responsible for taking it home and bringing it on the show day. Then students must bring back all hired costume items to the costume return day on Tuesday 16th of December between 3:00pm and 6:00pm in Studio 1 (31 Rawene Road). Please ensure that you take good care of your hired costume items (i.e. no eating or drinking while wearing costumes). Also, please make sure that no visible underwear is showing (nude underwear is available from the shop if needed).

HAIR AND MAKE-UP:

All students are required to wear stage make-up for the show. This is to ensure their faces can be seen under the bright stage lights. Stage make-up includes foundation, blusher, eyebrow pencil, eye-liner, and bright red lipstick. Their hair will also need to be done neatly (lots of hair gel and hair spray). Please find a list of the required hairstyles for each dance below. If you have any questions about this, please ask your teacher, or email me. Also, please make sure that no jewellery or nail polish is worn for the dress rehearsals or shows.

TICKETS:

Tickets can be ordered online www.shoredance.co.nz. Your child will receive their tickets during their class once payment has been made. All show tickets must be ordered by the 5th of December to ensure enough time for them to be delivered to the students. While there will be door sales on the days of the show, these will be cash only and we cannot guarantee that there will still be tickets available so we highly recommend you order your tickets in advance.

SHOW DVDS:

Both of our shows will be professionally filmed and DVDs will be available to buy. To order your copy of the show DVD, simply complete the order form on our website, or at the end of the term 4 newsletter (which is also on the website). DVDs will be available in the New Year.

SHOW PHOTOS:

We have a professional photographer photographing the students at the dress rehearsals. These photos will be collated on a disc and available to purchase for \$10.00. To order your copy of the show photo disc, simply complete the order form on our website, or at the end of the term 4 newsletter (which is also on the website). Show photo discs will be available in the New Year.
